Pilsner Old Fashioned 5% **\$5.50**

AKA "Saskatchewan's Champagne"! At Pilsner we have not changed since our beer was 1st brewed in 1926 by Fritz Sick right here in Lethbridge, Alberta. Why? It's right there on the bottle... "old style". Those are more than just words on a beloved label. Being true to who we are has kept our drinkers loyal and kept Pilsner from being a fad.

Mill Street Organic Lager (473ml can) 4.2% **\$7.50**

With our first offering, Original Organic Lager, we've used only imported organic New Zealand Hallertau Hops and Breiss Organics 2-Row Brewers Malt to create a uniquely refreshing lager with a distinct European flavour. We think it's a perfect complement to your healthy lifestyle and exceptional taste.

Granville Island Cypress Honey Lager 4.7% **\$6.00**

Brewed in small batches, our Cypress Honey Lager is lightly hopped, mild and bright, and given a hint of sweetness with pure Fraser Valley honey. It's like a refreshing blast of Cypress Mountain air.

Ribstone Creek (AB) Lager 5% **\$6.00**

This is the beer that started it all for Ribstone Creek. A 5% premium Lager that combines an easy-drinking finish with Ribstone's attention to detail. It pours pale gold with bright, sparkling clarity and a soft blanket of white head. The aroma offers delicate, grainy malt sweetness supplemented by a light grassiness and a hint of floral hop.

Alley Kat (AB) Scona Gold Kölsch 5% **\$6.25**

This light German style ale is a delightfully crisp and refreshing beer. Whether you are new to craft beer or a seasoned veteran, this simple yet flavourful ale is sure to please. Now crafted to be gluten reduced!

It is called the "model of meter" among beers. All other pilsners are a better or worse attempt to copy the original – the first ever Pilsner Urquell. Its unparalleled exceptionality is guaranteed by the same recipe dating from 1842.

LIGHT & EASY

Big Rock (AB) Grasshopper 5% \$5.75

German-Style Filtered Wheat Ale. Carefully aged and filtered for clarity and colour. Rich maltiness, the sweetness of Alberta wheat, a complex blend of hops and a note of citrus all lead to a bright, clean finish.

Tool Shed (AB) People Skills Cream Ale 5.2% \$6.25

Our session-able cream ale is light, refreshing and unlike Joe, tries to get along with everybody. This smooth, lightly hopped ale offers a beautiful mouth-feel and a golden, crystal clear appearance. It's a real, refreshing crowd pleaser.

Ölgerðin Egill Skallagrímsson (ICE) Borg Brío No. 1 Pilsner (500mL can) 4.8% \$8.00

Brio is a German-style pilsner and the Bavarian Mittelfruh hops give the beer its unique taste and aroma. Brio won gold at the prestigious 2012 World Beer Cup as the best German-style Pilsner and named the World's Best Pilsner in the 2012 World Beer Awards. Brio is the passionate pioneer of the group, always ready for an adventure!

Coulee Brew Co. (AB) Range Road Cream Ale 5.6% \$6.25

A pale golden glass of glory with malty aromas derived from wheat, oats, and the infamously Alberta 2 row barley. Tasting the marvellous beer reveals a sweet graininess with a silky texture leaving you longing for another glass...or two.

Coulee Brew Co. (AB) Devil's Coulee Kölsch 4.5% \$6.25

Who knows what will be revealed when we dig deep? It's all about getting down to the bare bones of things. That's exactly what this Kölsch does. Alberta barley combined with a portion of wheat showcases the complex interplay between malt and hops. Crowned with a delicate white head and almost imperceptible light fruit aromas, this beer is utterly refreshing. When you get down to it, that's exactly what a Kölsch should be.

Granville Island, Island Lager 5% \$6.00

Back in '84, we crafted our original lager at the tiny brewery on Granville Island. The finest quality ingredients give it a distinct hop flavour, golden colour and a clean, refreshing taste. Goes perfectly with barbecues, pizzas, and humble beginnings.

CRISP & FRUITY

Wild Rose (AB) Wraspberry 4.5% **\$6.50**

A crisp, easy-drinking beer with a twist. Raspberries are the beauty and the beast of fruit – tough and thorny, delicate and tasty. Wraspberry Ale continues a centuries-long tradition by using raspberries to give a tart edge to this smooth, refreshing ale. Legend has it that in the old west cowboys used raspberries to tame wild horses. We guarantee Wraspberry Ale does not have the same effect on wild cowboys.

Brewsters (AB) 52nd St Peach Ale 5% **\$6.25**

So popular it's become a full time brew! This crisp refreshing wheat beer has just a touch of sweet peachy goodness.

Fernie What The Huck (473ml can) 5% **\$7.50**

CIDERS & RADLERS & SWEETS

Tree Duke's Apple Cider 5% \$6.25

Made with 100% apples from Kelowna, Dukes dry apple cider is crisp, clean and refreshing. A subtle apple flavour and a dry finish. Enjoy over ice perhaps. They consider this cider gluten-free.

Angry Orchard (US) Crisp Apple Cider 5% \$6.75

Angry Orchard Crisp Apple has a bright, crisp apple flavour, just like biting into a fresh apple. It is a perfect balance of sweetness and bright acidity from culinary apples and dryness of traditional cider making apples, resulting in a complex, yet refreshing, hard cider.

Sonoma "The Anvil" Apple Cider with Bourbon (US) 6% \$7.50

With "The Anvil", the real spark ignited when we tossed nuance aside and added a healthy measure of our proprietary barrel-proof bourbon flavour. Suddenly, something intense, alive and memorable happened. To our palates, it offers a clean, lively, aromatic presence with a layered smoky finish. It's truly integrated and rounded, yet vitally distinct. Enjoy.

Big Rock (AB) Rock Creek Apple Cider 5.5% \$6.00

Apple with notes of vanilla and cinnamon, mouth feel is crisp and dry. Rock Creek Dry Cider is a premium Okanagan Cider consisting of a unique blend of Okanagan and European apple varieties grown in the Central Okanagan. Brewed with a combination of premium ingredients, the end result is an all natural refreshing dry cider that is richly condensed, perfectly balanced and full of character.

Big Rock (AB) Rock Creek Peach Cider 5.5% \$6.00

Brewmaster Paul blends ripened peaches with crisp apples for our newest offering from the Rock Creek family. Briskly carbonated, it pours a golden colour with a refreshing finish. Outside of slicing open a fresh peach in the peak of its harvest season, we think this one's hard to beat. Naturally gluten free.

Crabbies (UK) Alcoholic Ginger Beer (500ml can) 4% \$9.00

Served over ice, with a slice of lime.

Dark amber gold colour; fairly intense aromas of ginger, spice, with notes of oak and cedar; sweet, medium bodied, frothy carbonation, with flavours of sweet ginger, spice and citrus notes; pleasantly balanced and spicy on the finish.

Stiegl Radler Grapefruit (AT) 2.0% \$6.75

Stiegl Radler Grapefruit quenches your thirst and has a wonderfully fruity grapefruit aroma. 100% natural ingredients, 0% artificial sweeteners and colouring agents. Stiegl Radler Grapefruit is the perfect low alcoholic beverage for calorie conscious consumers.

WHITES & WHEATS

Unibroue Blanche De Chambly 5% \$7.25

It contains 5 percent alcohol and is produced from an interesting blend of unmalted Quebec wheat and pale barley malt, to which spices and natural aromatics are added, along with a light hopping. The Blanche is only partially filtered so that it retains the full benefits of its natural ingredients. While it is naturally of a champagne colour, it appears white because of the fresh yeast in suspension. It is the recent winner of World's Best Belgian Style Witbier at the World Beer Awards in London, UK.

Hoegaarden (BE) Classic Wit 4.9% \$7.25

Unfiltered Belgian White, flavoured with coriander and orange peel, creating a sweet & sour taste.

Kronenbourg (FR) 1664 Blanc 5% \$7.25

Kronenbourg 1664 Blanc is a fresh and fruity beer. This original refreshing white (wheat) beer is brewed with a hint of citrus, and coriander spice which makes it a sweet and unique flavour modern taste among all other wheat beers. This modernity is perfectly expressed through its unique shiny blue bottle of unique design.

Schneider (GR) Weisse (500mL can) 5.4% \$9.00

With its amber-mahogany colouring and streaked with fine top-fermented yeast, this beer has a fine, persistent head that adheres well to the glass. It is pleasantly fruity with a typical top-fermented smell, an aroma of clove and nutmeg apple tantalizes the nose. On the tongue it is fresh, clean, full-bodied, harmonious and well-balanced. It finishes with a light, delicate taste of bitters leaving behind a sour impression.

Erdinger (GR) Weissbrau Dunkel (500mL can) 5.3% \$9.00

Erdinger Dunkel is a rich and smooth wheat beer specialty from Erdinger Weissbräu. It owes its full-bodied flavour to the fine hops and dark malt used in its production.

Fernie Slow Drift Witbier (473mL can) 5% \$7.50

Fernie's Belgian White Ale is brewed with wheat, a distinctive Belgian yeast, a touch of coriander and curacao orange peel. In true Belgian style, this unfiltered beer has a signature cloudy appearance with light and spicy citrus flavours - making it a strong favourite with the European fans.

Theoretically Brewing (AB) Study Buddy Hefeweizen 5.6% \$6.50

Lethbridge's nano-brewery - their beers are unfiltered, unpasteurized, and contain no artificial flavours, colours or preservatives. Any sediment in the bottle can be mixed into the beer according to your personal taste. They have suggested adding lemon, lime, or orange slice to your Study Buddy.

BLONDES, BROWNS, AMBERS & REDS

Anchor (US) Steam Beer 4.8%

\$7.25

Anchor Steam® Beer owes its deep amber colour, thick, creamy head, and rich, distinctive flavour to a historic brewing process like no other. It is a process that combines deep respect for craft brewing tradition with many decades of evolution to arrive at a unique approach: a blend of pale and caramel malts, fermentation with lager yeast at warmer ale temperatures in shallow open-air fermenters, and gentle carbonation in our cellars through an all-natural process called kräusening.

Big Rock (AB) Honey Brown Lager 5%

\$5.75

Bernd chose to brew his honey beer as a dark lager, using a blend of pale and caramel malts. The slow lager process coated out the subtle molasses notes of the barley sugars. He balanced them with a dry note of hops and, at the last moment, added a very light touch of honey.

Lefte (BE) Blonde 6.6%

\$7.50

Lefte Blond is a pale abbey beer, with a full, sunny, golden colour. It has a smooth and full bodied taste and a rich creamy head. Like all the Lefte beers, it is a 'connoisseur' beer that is easy to drink.

Tool Shed (AB) Red Rage 5.6%

\$6.25

This beer is dark red, roasty like coffee, toasty like fresh bread and makes your mouth water for more. We put just enough hops in to remind you what they're capable of. This ale is medium bodied and easy to drink. Alberta Gingers Unite! It's time to KICK BACK!!!

Delirium Tremens (BE) "the pink elephant" 8.5%

\$8.00

The particular character and the unique taste of "Delirium Tremens" result from the use of three different kinds of yeast. It's very original packing, which resembles cologne ceramics, and the colourful label contribute to its success.

Granville Island Maple Shack Cream Ale 5%

\$6.00

A bronze-coloured ale that is brewed using traditional tettaang hops. We've taken a bold step forward with this one and added a hint of pure Canadian maple syrup for a creamy taste that is smooth, not sweet.

BLONDES, BROWNS, AMBERS & REDS

New Belgium Brewing (US) Fat Tire Amber Ale 5% \$7.00

Named in honour of our co-founder's bike trip through Europe, Fat Tire Amber Ale marks a turning point in the young electrical engineer's home brewing. Belgian beers use a far broader palette of ingredients (fruits, spices, esoteric yeast strains) than German or English styles. Together with co-founder Kim Jordan, they traveled around sampling their homebrews to the public. Fat Tire won fans with its sense of balance: toasty, biscuit-like malt flavours coasting in equilibrium with hoppy freshness. Fat Tire: Pairs well with people.

Unibroue Maudite 8% \$7.25

In November 1992 Maudite (the damned one), was the first strong beer to be distributed in Quebec grocery stores. Maudite is a mahogany-coloured, rich-tasting premium beer that has a distinctive, complex taste. Because of the warmth it releases, this strong character beer must be served cool but not cold. Perfect with pasta, red meats, stews and spicy dishes, it also makes a good aperitif and after-dinner drink. Gold medal winner in 1995 and 1996 and the Chicago Beverage Tasting Institute.

Rogue (US) Dead Guy Ale 6.5% \$8.00

Dead Guy is a German-style Maibock made with Rogue's proprietary "PacMan" ale yeast. It is deep honey in colour with a malty aroma, rich hearty flavour and a well balanced finish. Dead Guy is created from Northwest Harrington, Klages, Maier Munich and Carastan malts, along with Perle and Saaz Hops.

Troubled Monk (AB) Open Road American Brown Ale 5.5% \$7.25

A genuinely enjoyable, fruity and nutty American brown ale. In 2016, this Red Deer brewery received lots of publicity when this beer got 2nd place (out of 81 in the American Brown division) at the World Beer Cup.

Rogue (US) Hazelnut Brown Nectar (650ml bottle) 6% \$12.00

Dark brown in colour with a hazelnut aroma, a rich nutty flavour and a smooth malty finish. Hazelnut Brown Nectar Ale is a blend of Great Western 2-row Pale, Munich, Hugh Baird Brown, Crystal 80 and Crystal 135, Carastan, and Beeston Pale Chocolate malts; hazelnut extract; Perle and Saaz hops.

Coulee Brew Co (AB) Bears Hump Nut Brown 5.6% \$6.25

Fruity, toasty and nutty aromatics with layer of caramel and light chocolate throughout. Ends with a moderately dry graham cracker finish. This classic style is the universal food pairing beer that goes well with everything from roasted meats to pizza.

BIG, BITTER, BOLD, PORTERS & STOUTS

Innis & Gunn (UK) Original Oak Aged Beer 6.6% **\$7.50**

For 30 days this honey-hued beer sleeps in hand selected oak barrels, locked inside a bonded warehouse, gradually assimilating the subtle flavours that reside in the wood. Barrels are then emptied and maturation continues for a further 47 days in a marrying tun where these natural flavours infuse and fall into perfect balance. This 77-day process is unique and produces a delicious, refreshing beer: Aromas of vanilla and toffee, hints of citrus, with a malty, lightly oaked, palate. Deftly balanced and light in texture, soothing and warming in the finish.

Oskar Blues (US) Old Chub Scotch Ale 8% **\$7.50**

This jaw-dropping Scottish strong ale (8% ABV) is brewed with bodacious amounts of malted barley and specialty grains, and a dash of beechwood-smoked malt.

Legend 7 Brewing (AB) Dark Gate Porter 5% **\$6.50**

Brewed with Washington state nugget hops, our house ale yeast culture & pure natural vanilla extract, vanilla porter is nitrogen-charged to pour a thick, tight head with a creamy texture & body. Our vanilla extract is cold pressed from vanilla orchid bean pods giving it over 200 individual flavour notes (conventional hot extraction yields 50) resulting in a captivating depth of flavour and breadth of character.

Guinness (IR)(500mL can) 4.1% **\$8.00**

The unmistakable deep-dark colour, the crisp hint of roasted barley, the fresh breeze of hops, and the refreshing bite all make for the bittersweet reward.

Blindman Brewing (AB) Kettle Sour 4.5% **\$7.25**

Always changing. Always experimenting. Ask your server what the latest Kettle Sour serving is! Cheers.

Dieu Du Ciel Pêché Mortel 9.5% **\$7.50**

Pêché Mortel (French for "Mortal Sin") is an intensely black and dense beer with very pronounced roasted flavours. Fair trade coffee is infused during the brewing process, intensifying the bitterness of the beer and giving it a powerful coffee taste. Pêché Mortel is brewed to be savored; we invite you to drink it in moderation.

BITTER, BOLD, SOURS PORTERS & STOUTS

Deschutes (US) Black Butte Porter 5.2% \$8.00

With a dark beer as our first and flagship brand, Black Butte defined Deschutes as a radical player. A slight hop bitterness up front enhances the distinctive chocolate and roasted finish. It's prized for its creamy mouth feel and intense complex flavours.

Deschutes (US) Obsidian Stout 6.4% \$8.00

Deep, robust and richly rewarding, this is beer to linger over. Obsidian has distinct notes of espresso, chocolate, roasted malt and black barley, with just enough hop bite to cut the sweetness.

Chimay (BE) Red Cap - Abbey Dubbel 7% \$8.50

Chimay Red is noted for its coppery colour which makes it particularly attractive. Topped with a creamy head, it gives off a light, fruity apricot aroma produced by the fermentation. The taste perceived in the mouth is a balance confirming the fruity nuances noticed in the fragrance. Its taste, which imparts a silky sensation to the tongue, is made refreshing by a light touch of bitterness. To the palate, the taster perceives a pleasant astringency which complements the flavour qualities of this beer very harmoniously. This top fermented Trappist beer, refermented in the bottle, is not pasteurized.

Unibroue La Fin du Monde (Abbey Tripel) 9% \$7.00

"The end of the world" Triple fermented ale (seems to be in the Belgian blonde ale style). From the label: "The excellence of triple fermentation through a blend of special yeasts gives this malt beverage an exquisitely robust flavour of exceptional refinement".

Village Brewery (AB) Blacksmith Alberta Black Ale 5.4% \$6.25

Keep a sturdy grip on this hand-forged ale. It is an alloy of premium two-row Alberta barley, roasted to a black malt and infused with quantities of potent, bitter hops. Stalwart and bold, it will douse the coal-fired thirst, slake the spirit and clear the soot from the teeth.

Old Yale Sasquatch Stout (473ml can) 5% \$7.75

Coffee, chocolate, and mystery! Voted "Best Beer in Canada" for 2014, the Sasquatch Stout is smooth with notes of mocha, coffee and roasted barley.

IPAS & PALE ALES & SESSION ALES

Sierra Nevada (US) Pale Ale (473mL can) 5.6% \$8.25

Pale Ale began as a home brewer's dream, grew into an icon, and inspired countless brewers to follow a passion of their own. Its unique piney and grapefruit aromas from the use of whole-cone American hops have fascinated beer drinkers for decades and made this beer a classic, yet it remains new, complex and surprising to thousands of beer drinkers every day.

Blindman Brewing (AB) River Session Ale (473mL can) 4.4% \$8.25

Why start with a session ale? Here at Blindman Brewing we're fans of all styles. We like big, bold, barrel-aged stouts. We savour the puckering sour bombs. We revel in bitter early-boil hops that scrape our tongues. But what do we drink in between, or when we can't decide? We grab a beer that's brimming with flavour and effortlessly devoured - Blindman River Session Ale. Featuring an intense dry hop aroma and delicious hop taste with muted bitterness, it finishes dry and leaves us wanting another. It's a beer we can hand to friends knowing they'll dig it. It's a style we keep coming back to, no matter where our tastes may wander.

Mill Street Tankhouse Ale 5.2% \$6.00

Like traditional pale ales, Tankhouse Ale has a deep copper-red colour. We use five different malts to produce a complex malty texture. The most dominant character of our Pale Ale is the hop. The spicy Cascades is used to give an assertive hop flavour, aroma and bitterness to our ale. The result is a satisfying and complex-tasting beer. Our brewmaster developed this recipe 20 years ago and it has remained his favourite drink of choice.

Fernie Brewing Slingshot Session IPA 4.5% \$6.75

Slingshot Session IPA, is a lower alcohol alternative IPA. Dry hopped with Amarillo, Citra, Simcoe and Mosaic, which provide a citrusy, tropical fruit and some pine flavours and aromas.

Phillips Electric Unicorn White IPA 6.5% \$6.50

Sweet banana and fruit flavours are balanced against a citrus hop background that finishes dry. Perfect for the summer, but great all the time!

Deschutes (US) Fresh Squeezed IPA 6.4% \$7.50

A juicy citrus and grapefruit flavour profile. As if fresh Citra and Mosaic hops were squeezed straight into the bottle.

Ballast Point (US) Sculpin IPA 7% \$8.50

A trophy beer that's a testament to our homebrew roots. Our Sculpin IPA is a great example of what got us into brewing in the first place. After years of experimenting, we knew hopping an ale at five separate stages would produce something special. The result ended up being this gold-medal winning IPA, whose inspired use of hops creates hints of apricot, peach, mango and lemon flavours, but still packs a bit of a sting, just like a Sculpin fish.

Powell Brewing Ode To Citra Pale Ale (473mL can) 5.5% \$9.00

Our West Coast style pale ale showcases the tropical juiciness of the Citra hop. Aromas of mango and passionfruit lead into flavours of sweet citrus, with a subtle malt finish. A tribute to one of our favourite hops, this amber coloured beer is as flavourful as it is sessionable.

IPAS & PALE ALES & SESSION ALES



Hell's Basement Brewery (AB) Radiant IPA 6.5% \$6.50

Radiant IPA is our tribute to the sun and sunseekers! Radiant is bright like the sun and the crackers malts will allow the hops to shine on your palate with a burst of citrus and tropical hop flavour.

Fernie Lone Wolf IPA (650mL bottle) 6.5% \$11.00

This IPA has four select malts in combination with four classic hop varieties & time honoured traditional brewing methods including dry hopping, resulting in a golden ale with exceptional flavour & complexity. A true IPA in every sense.

Flying Monkeys SmashBomb Atomic IPA 6% \$6.75

"Holy Hop, Batman, this beer has aroma." Hops are casted nine different times, it's a breath-deep-and-shudder-with-pleasure kind of scent that's all from the Citra hops. With a high alpha acid of 11%, Citra has a cacophony of flavours and aromas – Citrus, passion fruit, grapefruit, lime, melon, lychee fruit, pineapple, mango, and papaya – and dominates this beer. With the first taste, Smashbomb's 70 IBUs are pronounced. This brew is a little bitter, but bitter like a grapefruit with three tablespoons of sugar on top. It's also incredibly drinkable.

New Belgium Brewing (US) VooDoo Ranger 6.2% \$7.00

Bring out the hops! This clear amber beauty bursts at the starting gate with an abundance of hops: Cascade (citrus), Chinook (floral/citrus), and Simcoe (fruity) lead off the beer, with Cascade added again for an intense dry hop flavour. Brewed with pale and dark caramel malts that harmonize the hop flavour from start to finish, VooDoo Ranger is a sessionable splendor for all you hopinistas. Thank your Beer Ranger!

Tree Hophead IPA 5.8% \$5.75

The Hophead is an extremely hoppy and flavourful beer, reminiscent of many American IPAs. The Hophead has a nice full body and mouth feel, without the hoppiness being too overpowering. A fine ale all around.

Driftwood Brewery Fat Tug IPA (650mL bottle) 7% \$11.00

Fat Tug is a northwest style India Pale Ale with an intense hop profile with notes of grapefruit, mango melon and passion fruit. Sufficient malt is there to provide support. At 7% alc/vol and 80+ IBUs this beer delivers on the promise to satisfy anyone with a thirst for all things hoppy!

Medicine Hat Brewing Industrial Ave IPA 6.7% \$6.75

Industrial Ave is where it all started for Medicine Hat Brewing Company back in 1912. This IPA is made to satiate the self proclaimed hophead. There is copious amounts of American style hops used in the brew kettle and dry hop additions to assault the senses with citric aromas and flavours. This beer boasts a 6.7% abv but the ibus are one that we must claim as questionable because once you reach a certain point, ibu's are immeasurable without a spectrophotometer – Industrial Ave is in that range.

Central City Super Solar IPA (473mL can) 6% \$7.50

Super Stellar IPA gets its juice from the combination of Mosaic & Citra hops. Juicy & citrusy notes, along with an intense aroma defeats gravity itself. Although the hops used were grown on planet Earth, we think this beer is "Out of This World!"

HAZY IPAs

Powell Brewing Lazy D'Haze IPA (473mL can) 7% \$9.00

A North Eastern Style Hazy IPA showcasing the juiciness of Amarillo and Equinox hops. Intense aromas of grapefruit, orange, apricot, melon, and berries are highlighted by the use of pale ale malt, vienna malt, and wheat. Let's enjoy these Lazy D'haze. 2017 Canadian Brewing Awards Gold Medal - American Style IPA Category.

Collective Arts Life in the Clouds Hazy IPA (473mL can) 6.1% \$8.00

Fall into the rich embrace of this New England style IPA. Simcoe and Mosaic hops balance each other to make this juicy IPA explosively fruit forward in both taste and aroma while curbing any unbearable sweetness to make an extremely drinkable beer.

The huge mouth feel ensures all of your tastebuds are enveloped in a blanket of tropical bliss, paradise in a can.

Hell's Basement Brewery (AB)

The Yard 'rotating' Milkshake IPA 6.2% \$6.75

Sweet banana and fruit flavours are balanced against a citrus hop background that finishes dry. Perfect for the summer, but great all the time! One of our biggest sellers of 2018, with flavours rotating between Pineapple, Strawberry, and Blackberry.

Blindman Brewing (AB)

New England-Style Pale Ale (473mL can) 6.5% \$8.25

New England-Style beers are American Pale Ales and IPAs that are most often described as hazy and juicy. The haze is due to the higher protein malts that are used as well as yeasts-like our English house yeast-that do not flocculate as well as the standard American Ale yeasts. This leaves particulates in the beer that give it the noted hazy appearance.

Parallel 49 – Trash Panda Hazy IPA 5.5% \$6.75

A Northeast style hazy IPA. Huge amounts of dry hopping give this beer complex notes of melon, tropical fruit, and pear.

This is a refined pleasure, with intense flavours of blackberry mingling with soft creamy touches of oak, vanilla and dry herbs. It's full on the palate, but not heavy and the fruit is constant from the first sip to the end of the finish.

Banrock Station Shiraz (AU)

The Banrock Station Shiraz exhibits lifted aromas of raspberry and sweet plum with hints of spice supported by vanilla oak. On the front palate sweet raspberry and dark berry fruits are present.
